The 2021 TIP development process was highly collaborative and executed in accordance with state/federal guidance. The TIP was prepared consistent with the SEDA-COG MPO Public Participation Plan; however, the COVID-19 pandemic prevented SEDA-COG from completing some traditional steps during the public comment period (e.g., placing hard copies of the draft TIP at government buildings and holding a physical meeting during the comment period). The changes to the public participation procedures for the 2021 TIP are documented in a memo dated April 9, 2020 and posted to SEDA-COG's website.


