INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. BIDS

- A. All bids must be submitted on forms supplied by the City of Williamsport, the Owner, and shall be subject to all requirements of the Contract Documents, including the product descriptions, and these INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS. All Bids must be regular in every respect and no inter-lineations, excisions, or special conditions shall be made or included in the Bid Form by the Bidder.**
- B. Bid Documents, including the completed Bid Forms, Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities, Certification of Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity, Identification of Individual, Partnership, or Corporate Principals, Bid Bond, and the Non-Collusion Affidavit shall be completed and submitted, sealed, and clearly labeled with the words "Fire" "Rescue" "Boat."**
- C. The Owner may consider irregular any Bid on which there is an alteration of or departure from the Bid Form hereto attached and at its option may reject or accept same.**
- D. If the Contract is awarded, it will be awarded by the Owner to a responsible Bidder on the basis of the lowest responsible bid.**

2. ALTERNATIVE BIDS

No alternative bids will be considered.

3. COLLUSIVE AGREEMENTS

Each Bidder submitting a Bid to the Owner shall execute and attach hereto, an affidavit substantially in the form herein provided, to the effect that they have not colluded with any other person, firm, or corporation in regard to any Bid submitted.

4. TIME FOR RECEIVING BIDS

Bids received prior to the advertised hour will be securely kept, sealed. The officer whose duty it is to open them will decide when the specified time has arrived, and no Bid received thereafter will be considered.

5. OPENING OF BIDS

At the time and place fixed for the public opening of Bids, the Owner, or their agent will cause to be opened and read aloud the Bid(s) received within the time set for receiving Bids, irrespective of any irregularities therein. Bidders and other persons properly interested may be present, in person, or by, representative.

6. AWARD OF CONTRACT: REJECTION OF BIDS

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible Bidder complying with the conditions of the invitation for Bids. The Bidder to whom the award is made will be notified at the earliest possible date. Bidders agree to honor their bid for not less than 45 days from the date of bid opening. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive any informality in Bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in its interest.

7. WARRANTY

A warranty of at least one year on all parts and labor is to be provided with no exceptions. There shall be no charge to the buyer for any travel, parts, or labor during this warranty period.

8. DELIVERY, OFF-LOADING

All equipment shall be delivered FOB Destination, Freight Collect.

The seller shall be responsible for the off-loading, uncrating, and inspection of all equipment, materials, and appurtenances.

9. EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirement for ensuring that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, sex, color, national origin, or religion. NON-DISCRIMINATION CLAUSE

During the terms of this contract, Supplier agrees as follows:

1. Supplier shall not discriminate against any employee, application for employment, independent Supplier or any other person because of race, color, religion, creed, ancestry, national origin, age or sex.
2. Supplier shall take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees or agents are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religious creed, ancestry, national origin, age or sex. Such affirmative action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruitment advertising, layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training.
3. Supplier shall post, in conspicuous places, available to employees, agents, applicants for employment and other persons, a notice to be provided by the contracting agency setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

 - iii) The Supplier will cause the foregoing provisions to be inserted in all subcontracts for any work covered by this contract so that such provisions will be binding upon each

subcontractor, provided that the foregoing provisions shall not apply to contracts or subcontracts for standard commercial supplies of raw materials.

- b) If the Contract amount exceeds \$10,000.00 or construction Contracts over \$2,000.00, the following conditions shall apply:
 - i) The Supplier will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex or national origin.  - ii) The Supplier will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employee's place by or on behalf of the Supplier, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin.
 - iii) The Supplier will send to each labor union or representative of workers with which he has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice to be provided advising the said labor union or worker's representatives of the Supplier's commitments under this section, and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.
