Background

SEDA – Council of Governments (SEDA-COG) has negotiated a group price for engineering/survey services to complete and issue FEMA Elevation Certificates for interested homeowners in the Borough of Danville who reside within the 100-year floodplain (Zone AE). The cost is \$650.00, prepaid to SEDA-COG. There are no income restrictions applied to this program.

The National Flood Insurance Program has gone through significant changes with the 2012 Biggert-Waters Flood Insurance Reform Act and 2014 Homeowner Flood Insurance Affordability Act. These reforms mean that policy holders with subsidized Pre-FIRM or grandfathered rates may see premium rate increases until FEMA deems that the flood insurance cost is based on the true flood risk to that property.

An elevation certificate provides detailed property information, including specific elevations, building type, location, and any additional information used to determine the proper flood insurance premium rates for a property. As such, elevation certificates often reduce the cost of flood insurance by more accurately assessing the true flood risk for a specific property.
