

**WELSH HEIGHTS
ELDERLY APARTMENT COMPLEX**

Applications are now being accepted from eligible elderly individuals who wish to rent a one- or two-bedroom apartment at 1781 Fleming Avenue, Danville, Pennsylvania.

WHAT IS WELSH HEIGHTS?

The apartment complex consists of 24 individual living units (2 two bedroom and 22 one bedroom) designed to house senior citizens 62 years of age or older. All apartments consist of a combined kitchen/dining area, living room, bedroom, and bathroom. All apartments are TV cable and high-speed internet ready. The facility also has luxuriously furnished community space located throughout. This space includes a community room, sitting lounges, a library, a computer lab, and a three-season porch.

NOTE: Two of the apartments are designed for handicapped residents who need accommodations for wheelchairs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Individuals who are at least 62 years of age, and whose annual incomes are less than 60% of the area's median income are eligible. The limits are as follows:

HOW MUCH RENT DOES A RESIDENT PAY?

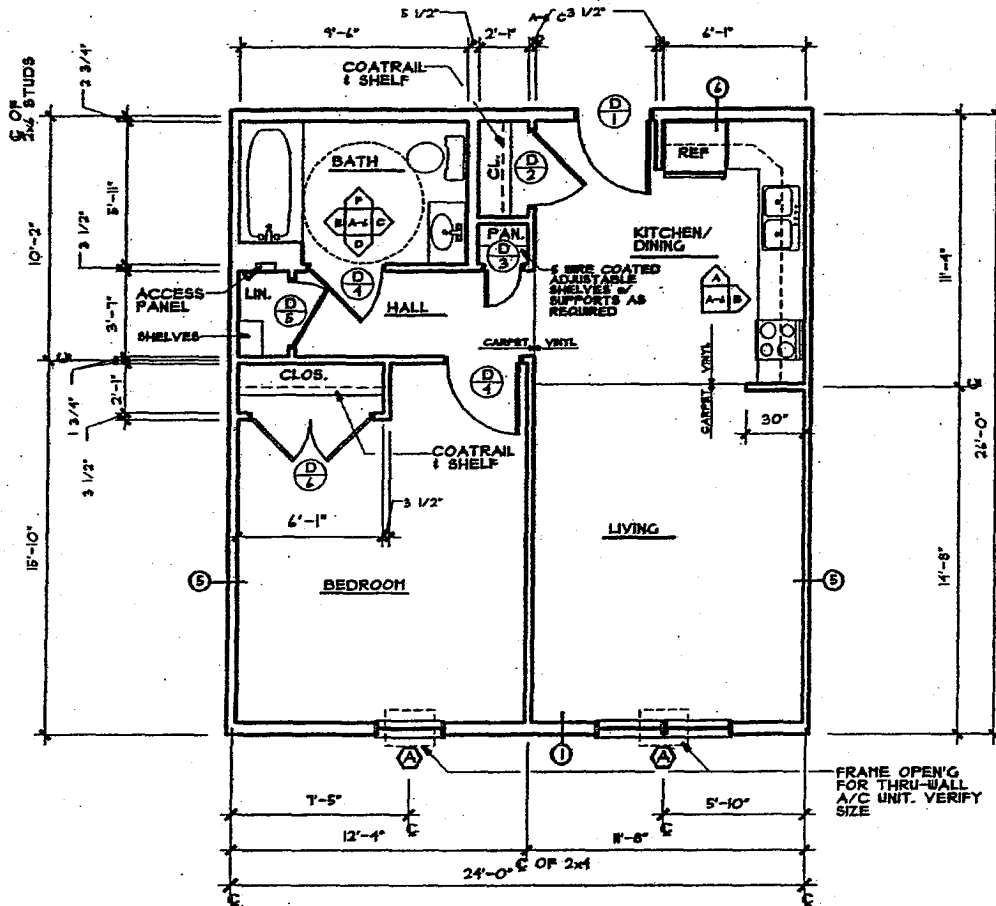
\$672 (one bedroom unit); \$782 (two bedroom unit) per month depending on your income. The monthly rental includes all utilities with the exception of cable television and telephone.

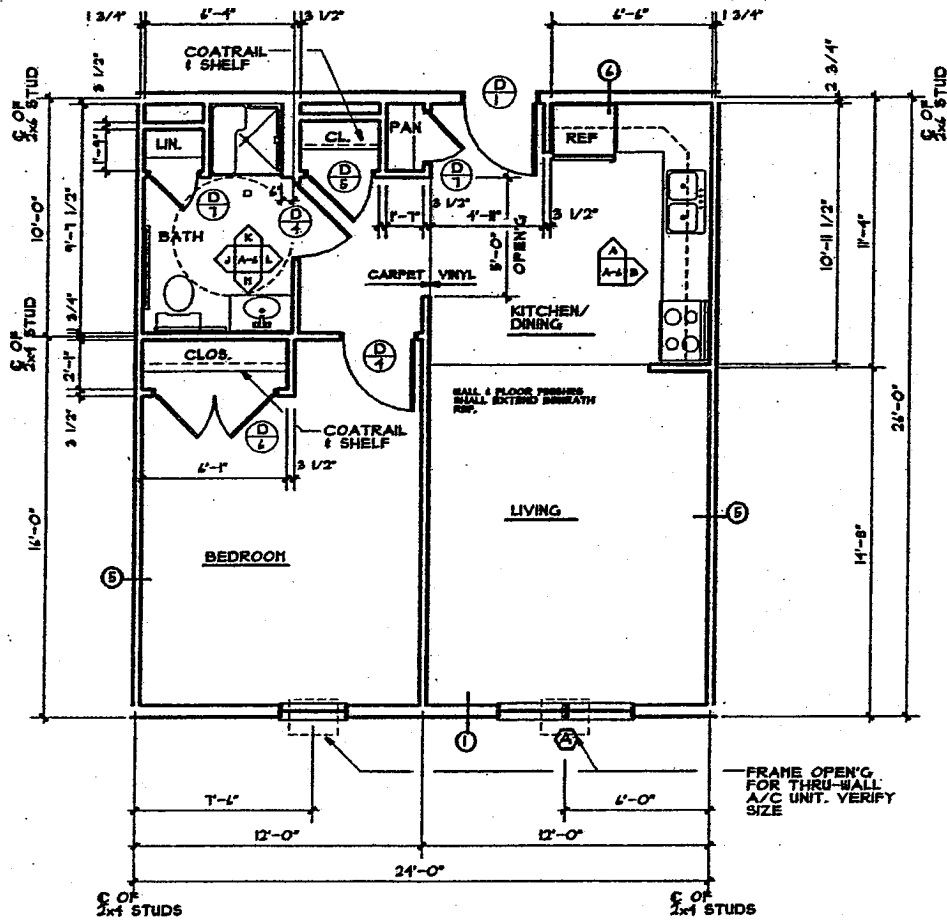

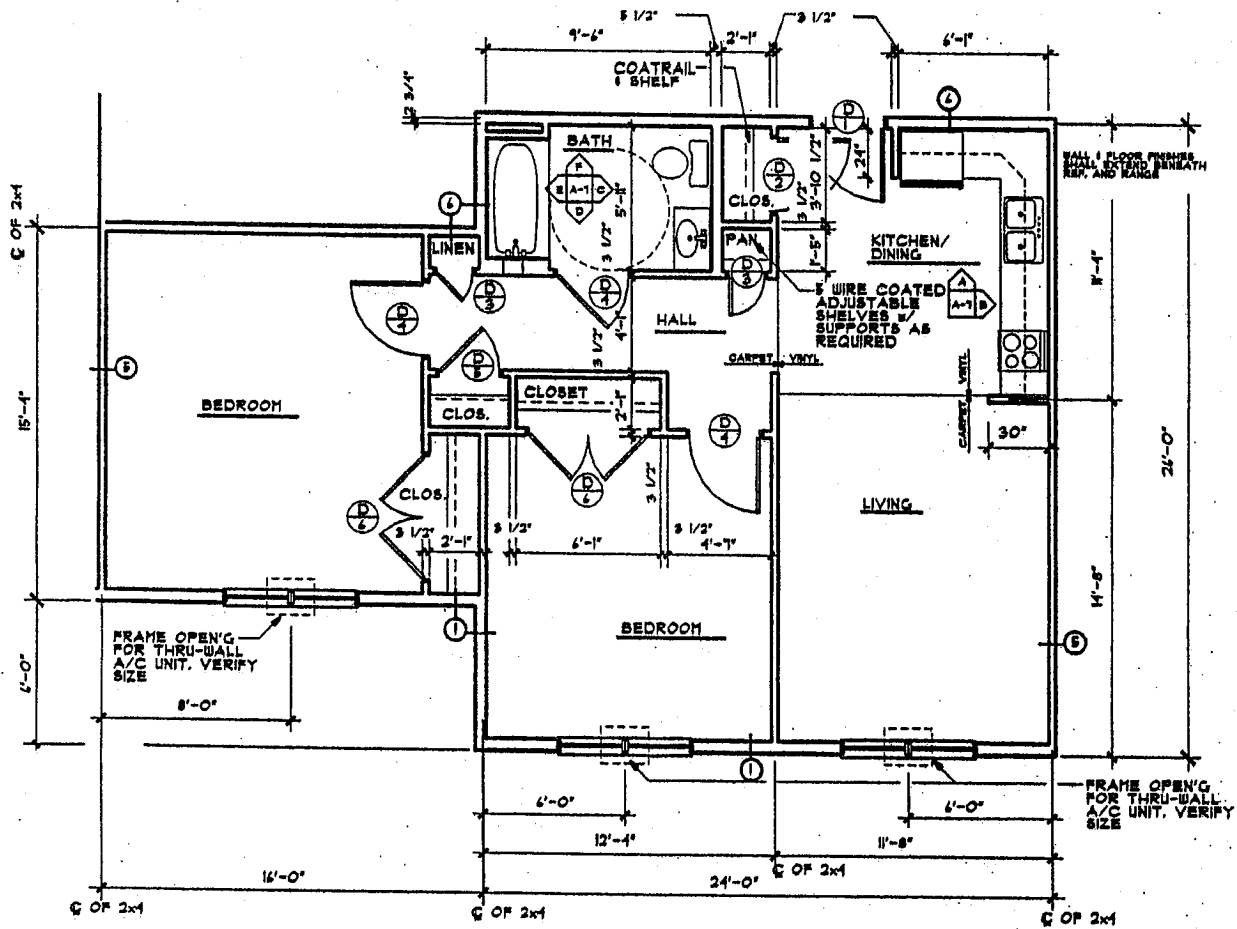
**TYPICAL ONE
