Call to Order

After it was determined that a quorum was present, Mr. Herman called the meeting to order at 9:33 a.m.

Public Forum

No comments were received from the general public. Mr. Herman introduced Ms. Michelle Ballou, Program Assistant for the JRA/Transportation/Natural Gas Cooperative, and Bryce Buck, GIS Program Analyst.

Approval of the November 18, 2022, Meeting Minutes of the SEDA-COG MPO

TIP Administrative Modifications and Amendments

Mr. Schultz summarized the TIP amendments for PennDOT District 2-0.

Mr. Schultz summarized the TIP administrative modifications for PennDOT District 2-0.

Mr. Hampton made a motion for the MPO to approve the TIP administrative modifications for PennDOT District 2-0; Mr. Kerstetter seconded the motion; motion carried.

Mr. Ranck summarized the TIP administrative modifications for PennDOT District 3-0.

Mr. Colussy made a motion for the MPO to approve the TIP administrative modifications for PennDOT District 3-0; Mr. Schultz seconded the motion; motion carried.

Mr. Herman referenced the interactive webmap prepared by Mr. Buck as a guide for the TIP modifications that was included with the advance meeting packet. The webmap was brought up via shared screen during the meeting to highlight some of the functionality and project details.

CSVT Project and SR 54 Safety Project Status Reports

Mr. Ranck provided the following updates:

CSVT Northern Section

Work has been completed. The section is open and functioning well.

CSVT Southern Section

First Contract for Earthwork: Construction activities are occurring and fluctuate depending on weather conditions. PPL recently completed and energized the last of their electric transmission lines that needed to be relocated for CSVT.

Second Contract for Structures: The individual plans for nine new bridge projects are wrapping up and final reviews are underway. PennDOT anticipates letting the contract later this year and starting construction work on the structures next year.

CSVT Traffic Volume Study

PennDOT is summarizing traffic counts that were taken in the Fall of 2022 to show how the Northern Section's opening has changed traffic volumes on existing roads. This should be finalized by early February. PennDOT will issue a press release about the preliminary traffic counts.

Update on rabbittransit Stop Hopper Service

Mr. Juba provided a presentation on ridership updates for rabbittransit's Stop Hopper microtransit services currently available in the region (Sunbury-Selinsgrove, Lewisburg-Milton, and Bloomsburg-Danville). From October 1-December 31, 2022, there were 122 riders per day across these zones.

Mr. Noon provided a presentation regarding rabbittransit's administration and oversight of the Intercity Bus Program that provides long-distance, fixed-schedule transportation. Fullington Trailways and Greyhound are current operators of the service, and there are 17 stops in the SEDA-COG region.

Ms. Nidam reviewed a flyer regarding rabbittransit's same day shared ride pilot program.

Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Update

Mr. Herman highlighted items from the SEDA-COG MPO Staff Activity Report – January 2023 provided in the meeting packet.

Mr. Herman reviewed the handout outlining the 2025 TIP local bridge prioritization process. Staff will poll MPO members to schedule initial county prioritization meetings over the next few weeks.

Mr. Buck provided an update on the Active Transportation Committee. The first committee meeting of 2023 will be on February 15, 2023, and the meeting agenda was provided as a handout.
